Introduction to Wine Appreciation

Wine 101 is designed for **everyone** interested in learning more about the wonderful, yet sometimes confusing, world of wine. This class meets once a week for 4 weeks at Amalthea Cellars in Atco. The classes focus on the world's principal grape varieties and how they produce different styles of wine around the world. While **sampling 8-10 wines per class** you will learn the proper evaluation techniques to develop personal skills for tasting, describing, and selecting wine. You will also learn about the wine growing areas of the world, how to read their wine labels, and proper pronunciations.
